Section 4. First-Aid Measures

4.1 Description of First Aid Measures

Inhalation: Remove victim to fresh air. Drink water to clear throat and blow nose to remove dust. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Skin contact: Rinse skin thoroughly with water for several minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and laundry before re-use. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Eye contact: Do not rub your eyes. Dust particles may cause abrasive eye injury. Rinse cautiously with water for 5 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing for 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.

Ingestion: If small quantities are swallowed, rinse out mouth with water. Drink plenty of water to help reduce irritation. If large amounts are swallowed or if irritation or discomfort occurs, get medical attention.

4.2 Most Important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed:

Causes severe eye irritation and possible damage. Causes skin irritation. May cause mechanical (abrasive) eye and skin irritation. May cause mild respiratory irritation.

4.3 Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed:

Seek immediate medical attention for eye contact.

Section 5. Fire-Fighting Measures

5.1 Suitable (and unsuitable) extinguishing media: Use any media that is suitable for the surrounding fire.

5.2 Specific hazards arising from the chemical: This material is not flammable or combustible.

adequate ventilation. Launder contaminated clothing before re-use. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Follow good housekeeping practices.
